The Family Council of the John Noble Home would like you to help us out by giving us a moment of your time to sign a petition! This petition is extremely important to the well being of any resident that you may know in "the home". The petition is beside the " SIGN IN VISITOR'S BOOK " as well as in our "SKYLIGHT CAFE". It will go to the Legislative Assembly of Ontario and we need to get this petition in the mail by September 15th 2017.

Simply stated the most detailed and reputable studies of MINIMUM care standards recommend at least 4 hours of direct care for each resident per day in a long term care facility. Right now they receive approximately 2.86 hours of nursing and personal care . There is just not enough time allotted and staff provided to each resident and this petition is to amend the Long Term Care Homes Act (2007) so that a long term care home will have to provide residents with a minimum of 4 hours per day of nursing and personal support service.

The next time you drop in to the John Noble Home PLEASE take a moment to sign this very important petition. You are welcome to take a copy or two with you and get others to sign it. Just remember to drop it back off before September 15th or send it to the address listed on the petition before September 15th.

Why should all of us care? Because one day it may personally matter to you or a loved one how much nursing and support services are provided. Please make a special effort to stop in before September 15th to give us a moment of your time.

If we don't care nothing will change and improve.
