

CASUAL PERSONAL SUPPORT WORKER

POSITION SUMMARY: The Personal Support Worker is responsible for providing assistance with all activities of daily living, as well will support and follow the plan of care for behaviour management and continence care. The PSW/HCA will promote independence and foster an environment that is safe and home-like.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

- (i) the vocational standards established by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities,
- (ii) the standards established by the National Association of Career Colleges, or
- (iii) the standards established by the Ontario Community Support Association; and
- (iv) must be a minimum of 600 hours in duration, counting both class time and practical experience time
- (v) Minimum one-year experience in geriatric, rehabilitative or other long-term care setting preferred.
- (vi) Proof of ongoing education related to health care

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the direction of the Registered Nurse and/or the Registered Practical Nurse assumes the responsibility for providing direct care to the resident according to the care plan/kardex in the following areas: **Activities of Daily Living** which includes; Bathing, Dressing, Toileting, Transferring, Feeding
