SAFETY TALK

Read & Initial

September 2019

Working safely is everyone's responsibility.

All Staff & Volunteers should make it a habit of starting each shift by checking with the Registered Staff when starting work on a Home Area. Ask if there is anyone with an increased risk of Responsive Behaviours that you should be aware of. Are there any triggers you should avoid for that Resident? What is the best approach for that Resident if you notice an escalation in their behaviour?



Always be aware of the people around you and look for signs of escalating behaviours.

It takes a team so please share any thoughts or observations you have with the Registered Staff regarding a Residents triggers or successful redirection and de-escalation methods for individual Residents.

Remember to report all Workplace Violence and Harassment, even if you have not been injured.
